A Word from Karen About Screen Time:

Social and Emotional Development

It's particularly worrying that evidence is mounting that when we use screens to calm our children or to keep them amused, their empathetic abilities – the near instinctive way you and I can read situations and get a feel for people – will be dulled, possibly for good. When they miss out on valuable face-to-face time with you, they also miss out on moment-by-moment interactions that teach them how to engage, connect, respond, and be attuned to emotions of others, and manage socially.

And, if they don't yet power down at meal times, and are taking their device into the bedroom, now might be a good time to change that!

At NCS we want to see our kids grow and develop into the people God has created them to be. For that to happen they need time with those who can model what its like to know and love God much more than they need to spend hours interacting with an electronic device.
