Tasmanian Youth Local Government - Leadership Program

City of Launceston is offering 2 sponsored positions for the Tasmanian Youth Local Government Program for students in Grades 9 & 10. The Tasmanian Youth Local Government program aims to empower its participants to engage with local issues, represent their community and collaborate on policy ideas. Nominees from each region will come together with representatives from around the state to debate social and development issues whilst gaining worthwhile experience in community consultation.

Participants of this program will produce submissions and project proposals, which will be presented to Councilors at the program's conclusion, with the hopes that some of these proposals may be adopted by local governments throughout our state.

The program will take place in Term 3 school holidays consists of two parts: a Launceston workshop and a residential weekend in Hobart.

The Launceston Workshop will be on Saturday 7th October from 9am - 4:30pm at YMCA in Kings Meadows. Students will be required to bring their own lunch.

The residential weekend will be held on Saturday 14th of October and Sunday 15th of October in Hobart. This residential weekend will consist on developing on the ideas and concepts identified as vital to youth on a Local Government level. However, this weekend will not be purely business. This weekend will include social activities that will allow participants to meet like-minded students from across the state. All accommodation, meals, and travel costs to and from Hobart are covered as part of City of Launceston's sponsorship.
