# Trip to Canberra:



On 26<sup>th</sup> September, 19 Students, Mr Green and Ms Hooley, met at Launceston Airport and headed off to Canberra for a four-day education tour of our nation's capital. This tour gave our students the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. We cleared security with the loss of only one pair of scissors and we were on

our way. Once in Sydney, we grabbed our bags and headed off to meet Grant, our friendly bus driver.

The next few days were an amazing whirlwind of some of the best sights Canberra has to offer: From the heights of the Telstra Tower, to the energy of the Australian Institute of Sport, the solemnity of the War Memorial and the beauty of the National Art Gallery. We debated and voted on the introduction of a Sugar Tax at the New Houses of Parliament and explored Australia's voting system as we voted for different fruits at the Old Houses of Parliament. We even managed to squeeze in an evening of rock climbing and an hour's shopping.

Before we knew it, we were back on the bus and heading to Sydney Airport, via the obligatory stop at Mrs. Macquarie's Chair for a glimpse of the Opera House and the Harbour Bridge. Finally, we arrived back where we began at Launceston Airport. Tired but happy, we were met by many excited parents keen to see their children again. It was a privilege to visit our fine capital, to be reminded of the sacrifice of so many who fought and continue to fight for our freedom, to be inspired by the athletes and the artists of this Great South Land and to acknowledge the privilege and responsibility that our parliamentary system offers. Our students were a credit to themselves and our school at all times and it was a pleasure to take this trip with them.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$150 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards costs. This

rebate will be paid directly to the school once the excursion is completed and all necessary paperwork submitted.
